**You Must Be in One of the Following Priority Groups
to Receive a Vaccination at the Clinics Listed Below.**

H1N1 Vaccine Priority Groups:

- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for infants younger than 6 months of age
- Health care and emergency medical personnel
- Anyone from 6 months through 24 years of age
- Anyone from 25 through 64 years of age with certain chronic medical conditions or a weakened immune system

People 65 and older, and other non-priority individuals should NOT attend the clinics listed below.

**Everyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied
by a parent or legal guardian.**
