2021 UNDERPAYMENT OF CARE

We are a non profit guided by a mission to offer all Central Vermonters equal access to care. This means that we provide care to individuals regardless of their ability to pay. In 2021, we provided \$959,693 in care for which we were not fully reimbursed by Medicare, Medicaid, third-party private insurance companies, or by the patient and their families. We rely on fundraising and town funding to make up this difference.


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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
